<p><b>Variations</b></p>	 <p>Pupils are welcome to blue gingham dresses/skirts/playsuits</p>	
<p><b>Make Up and Nails</b></p>	<p>Children are not permitted to wear makeup of any kind while in uniform. This includes foundation, lipstick, eyeshadow, mascara, or any other cosmetic products.</p> <p>Nails should be kept natural. Nail polish, artificial nails, or any nail decorations are not allowed while in uniform.</p>	
<p><b>Hair</b></p>	<p>We recognise that hair styles can reflect culture and identify and we do not have rules which limit each child's uniqueness. We would ask that head scarves, wraps, bobbles and bows reflect the spirit of school uniform and match our colours. We recommend that long hair is tied back to reduce outbreaks of headlice. Children may be asked to tie long hair back for certain practical lessons.</p>	
<p><b>Jewelry</b></p>	<p>Ideally NO jewelry should be worn to school but, if necessary, we will permit:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· Small gold stud earrings</li> <li>· Sikh Kara bracelets</li> <li>· Wrist watch</li> </ul> <p>We apply advice from the PE Association to daily life in school as the children are physically active throughout the day.</p>	<p><b>Earrings</b></p> <p>School adults <b>WILL NOT</b> remove earrings for a child.</p> <p>If a pupil is sent to school in earrings, it may be necessary to exclude them from elements of lessons and playtimes.</p> <p>If you feel there is a genuine reason why your child cannot remove jewelry or stick to policy, please send them to school with tape over their earrings.</p>

<p><b>Shoes</b></p>	<p>Black smart and sensible – plain black trainers and fuss free ankle boots are allowed. All shoes should be suitable for outdoor play in all weathers. <b>Please do not buy heels or slip-on ballet pump style.</b></p>

<p><b>Lunch boxes</b></p>	<div data-bbox="315 758 689 1141" data-label="Image"> </div> <div data-bbox="725 815 1832 911" data-label="Text"> <p>Small lunch box or bag which fits a drink bottle. We do not have the storage capacity for large bags or rucksacks.</p> </div>	

<p><b>Water bottles</b></p>	<p>Please send your child with a 500ml water bottle, these fit our classroom storage holders. Please <b>do not</b> send large alternatives. The bottles stay in classrooms during the day. <b>WATER ONLY</b> – if a pupil brings juice/squash they will be offered two <b>choices</b>:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Save until home time and use school cups instead</li> <li>2) Pour it away and refill with water</li> </ol> <p>Pupils on packed lunches need a separate drink to accompany their food.</p>	
<p><b>PE Kit</b></p>	<p>School House t-shirt and <b>black bottoms</b> (shorts, leggings, tracksuit bottoms, cycling shorts) with school sweatshirt when an extra layer is needed. Plain black pumps or trainers.</p>	
<p><b>Supply</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• School sweatshirts, ties and house PE tops are available from Term Time Wear and Natasha in Huddersfield town centre</li> <li>• Generic uniform items are also available in local supermarkets</li> <li>• Free recycled uniform is available to all Kirklees residents from Uniform Exchange <a href="http://www.uniform-exchange.org">www.uniform-exchange.org</a></li> </ul>	
<p>Pupils will be given class dojos and praise for wearing the correct uniform, they will be chosen to do jobs and to represent their class, year group and our school.</p> <p><b>Consequences for not sticking to school uniform policy:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reception-Y2 gentle reminders, parents informed and asked to rectify non uniform choices</li> <li>• Y3-Y5 - as above but with some expectation that pupils begin to take responsibility for themselves, parents informed</li> </ul> <p>Y5-Y6 - high expectations every day, pupils will be excluded from jobs and responsibilities, parents informed</p>
